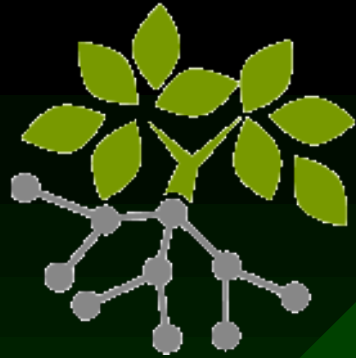

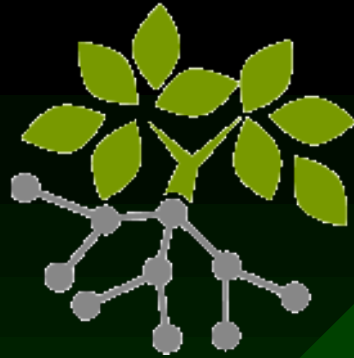

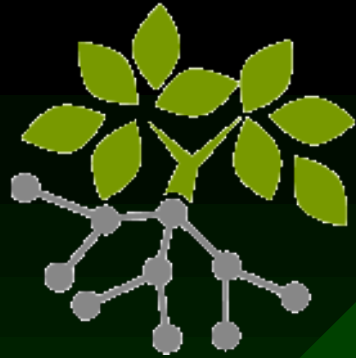




Moving
